Assess and address community needs.

- Construct a community improvement plan based on results from community mapping activities.
- Organize community improvement projects to address some of the needs identified in your improvement plan.
- Collaborate with community leaders.

Skills

Construct references related to politics within the United States.

- Construct a display that explains how branches of the government work together and the importance of being an informed voter.
- Compile information on political candidates for local or state elections.
- Rank major political issues on a scale of importance as they relate to you personally.
- Develop a list of criteria that should be considered when deciding among political candidates.
- Compare and contrast the local political system to that of the state and federal level.

Evaluate careers related to public service.

- Compile a list of possible public service careers that interest you.

Share with others the value of different cultures within a community.

- Discuss with community members what they believe makes up the your community's culture.
- Plan a community culture night where community members can share pieces of their culture with others.

Create short- and long-term volunteer plans

- Work with others to design a long-term volunteerism plan for your club.
- Develop a short- and long-term volunteer plan for yourself.

Create long-standing partnerships with organizations in your community.

- Compile a list of organizations you would like to be a member of after high school graduation.
- Collaborate with community organizations to discuss your community improvement plan.
