Create a list of career goals.

- Discuss college and career options with leaders in your community.
- Develop a list of career goals that are achievable in the next five years.

Develop a teaching module for presentation and listening styles.

- Develop a resource for others to use that discusses different listening and presentation strategies.
- Discuss your listening skills with your peers to find ways you can improve.

Create a teaching tool to reinforce the importance of organization skills.

- Create a team management model that can be used by others in the club.
- Assess the effectiveness of using different team management models.
- Propose to community leaders different events to teach decision-making, collaboration and goal-setting.
- Design different teaching tools to help educate the community on goal-setting and decision-making.
- Plan networking events for members of your community.
- Design teaching tools and resources for community members to learn listening and presentation skills.

Help younger members develop creativity and planning skills.

- Continue to improve the organization skills of your club members.
- Create a teaching tool to reinforce the importance of strong organizational skills for younger members.
- Increase the club members' decision-making abilities by holding trainings and educational sessions.
- Develop a model to use as a resource for making attainable goals.
- Compose materials that help club members increase their planning and creative skills.
- Create a plan for community organizational skill learning events.
- Schedule and implement events to teach community organization skills.

Dispositions

Value the importance of following a project management model.

- Assess possible conflicts in the club and develop a resolution plan.
- Compile a list of other organizations that use different project management strategies and evaluate each.
- Discuss conflict management techniques with other organizational leaders.
- Design a project management model that can be used by yourself and others in multiple situations.
- Assess what types of time, stress, project and conflict management skills you will need in your career.

Verify the need for prioritization of skills and commitments.

- Discuss potential conflicts you will face after graduation with people you trust.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of your time management over the past month.
- Determine what organizations in your career fields prefer in terms of creative and planning skills.
- Assess how well members in the community collaborate with each other in different situations.
- Assess how effective community leaders are in sharing and listening to the members of the community.

Display the mindset that decisions made can affect other decisions in the future.

- Evaluate past decisions made and determine other possible outcomes had the decision been made differently

Value constructive criticism as a tool for professional improvement.

- Criticize goals you have made in the past and discuss how they could have been better defined.
- Determine the best listening and sharing strategies that will be used in your chosen career field.
- Research the importance of good listening and sharing skills as a professional.

Analyze different skills individuals bring to a group.

- Assess how well the club has met previously established goals.
- Create an evaluation tool to be used in decision-making.
- Appraise how the club's collaboration skills have improved over the past month
- Evaluate the club's planning and creative skills.
- Interpret how different members of your community share and listen.

Understand the effect community decisions have on you as an individual.

- Determine what types of goals and decisions will be set and made in your career field.
