



Know Your Government

Bill No. 0004



AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Education Chapter 6, relative to the “Elimination of the Usage of Standardized Tests as Admission Requirements.”

BE IT ENACTED BY THE 2021 TENNESSEE 4-H CONGRESS:

SECTION 1: Standardized testing shall be defined as tests designed to measure a Student’s college aptitude such as the Scholastic Assessment Test & the American College Test.

SECTION 2: This act prohibits Colleges and Universities in Tennessee from requiring the submission of ACT/SAT scores in entrance applications.

SECTION 3: Schools found in violation with this act will be fined \$120,000 per violation.

SECTION 4: All laws or parts of law in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: This act shall become effective upon passage by the legislature and approval by the Governor or upon its otherwise becoming a law.

SECTION 6: Upon approval by the governor, this bill will be reviewed for funding by the appropriation committee.
