

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Education Chapter 6, relative to the "Elimination of the Usage of Standardized Tests as Admission Requirements."

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE 2021 TENNESSEE 4-H CONGRESS:

**SECTION 1:** Standardized testing shall be defined as tests designed to measure a Student's college aptitude such as the Scholastic Assessment Test & the American College Test.

**SECTION 2:** This act prohibits Colleges and Universities in Tennessee from requiring the submission of ACT/SAT scores in entrance applications.

**SECTION 3:** Schools found in violation with this act will be fined \$120,000 per violation.

**SECTION 4:** All laws or parts of law in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5:** This act shall become effective upon passage by the legislature and approval by the Governor or upon its otherwise becoming a law.

**SECTION 6:** Upon approval by the governor, this bill will be reviewed for funding by the appropriation committee.
