



4-H Shooting Sports Volunteer Leader Position Description

Position Title:	Volunteer Leader (Archery, Rifle, Shotgun, Black Powder, or Hunting), 4-H Shooting Sports Program.
Time Commitment:	Length of service is one year – renewable. Program ranges from 8-36 hours.
Location:	Serve within the county or area.
Type of Position:	Volunteer leader, no direct salary.
Supervision:	4-H Shooting Sports Discipline Instructor, Coordinator, and Extension professional in charge of 4-H programs.
General Purpose:	Assist the instructor in supervising and behavior management of 4-H participants.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Supervise and manage the behavior of participants
- Follow acceptable behavior management techniques
- Attend shooting club meetings and activities
- Participate in training programs specified by the 4-H Shooting Sports committee
- Assist with yearly program planning
- Promote other 4-H activities and events
- **CANNOT be in charge of any live-fire events (4-H certified instructor required)**

Qualifications:

- Ability to work with youth
- Interest in and knowledge of shooting sports
- Familiar with 4-H objectives and philosophy or willing to learn
