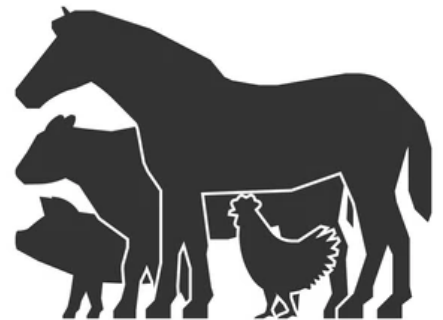


**Do you love animals?
