



4-H Shooting Sports Certified Instructor Position Description

Position Title: **Discipline Instructor** (Archery, Rifle, Shotgun, Black Powder, or Hunting), 4-H Shooting Sports Program.

Time Commitment: Length of service is one year – renewable. Three-year commitment preferred. Program ranges from 20-100 hours yearly.

Location: Serve within the county or area.

Type of Position: Volunteer key leader, no direct salary.

Supervision: Area/County 4-H Shooting Sports Coordinator, and/or Extension professional in charge of 4-H programs.

General Purpose: Responsible for teaching discipline related skills to 4-H'ers.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Teach shooting safety
- Coordinate activities with shooting sports coordinator
- Coach members on proper shooting techniques
- Attend shooting club meetings and activities
- Recruit and train assistant instructors
- Assist coordinator in securing needed equipment and facilities
- Recruit parents and 4-H members
- Participate in training programs specified by the sports committee
- Promote other 4-H activities and events
- **In charge of any live-fire events**

Qualifications:

- Age 21 or older
- Ability to work with youth and adults
- Interest in and knowledge of shooting sports
- State certification in shooting disciplines, recertification as required
- Familiar with 4-H objectives and philosophy or willing to learn
