SPECIFIC AIR RIFLE COMPETITION RULES AND GUIDELINES (2023 Revisions in Red)

NATIONAL STD THREE-POSITION SPORTER AIR RIFLE

- Age Classes:There will be three age classes: Junior (4-5 grade), JuniorHigh (6-7 grade) and Senior (8-12 grade).
- **Entry Limit:** There is no limit of individuals per county, regardless of age division
- **Entry Fee:** There is an entry fee of \$20.00 per entry

Target:NRA AR 5/10 (Orion)

Distance: 10 meters or 33 feet

Course of Fire: 3 x 10. 10 shots each position: prone, standing, and kneeling in that order. (30 record shots)

Time Limit: Prone – 10 shots in 10 minutes. Standing – 10 shots in 15 minutes. Kneeling – 10 shots in 10 minutes. (see CMP book 5.3.2)

Scoring: Targets will be scored using the Orion system.

Awards: Awards will be given to the top individuals in each age class. In addition, county team awards will also be given in each age class. County team awards will be given by adding the top four scores from each county. Awards will be given on the day of the event following the completion of shooting and score calculations. Scores will be posted online by noon, the Wednesday after the event. Any awards not picked up at the presentation on that day will be sent to the agents in participating counties to distribute.

Qualifying For the State 4-H Invitational: Individuals that score 200 out of 300, from the 8-12 grade will be invited to the State 4-H Invitational to be held in Fall, 2023. The State 4-H Invitational will be the qualifying match for the National 4-H

Shooting Sports Championships in June 2024 in Grand Island, Nebraska (not all competitors may be eligible for Nationals).

Equipment: Air Rifles officially approved for Sporter Class air rifle competitions are the Air Force Air Guns Edge, Crosman CH2000 (CO2), Crosman CH2009 (CO2 or CA), Crosman CH2021 (CA), Daisy M599 Competition Air Rifle, Daisy M853/753/953/853CM (pneumatic), Daisy 888/887 (CO2), Daisy XSV40 Valiant (compressed air), Air Arms T200 (compressed air, with non-adjustable cheekpiece and butt-plate) and the Champions Choice T200 (CZ 200T, compressed air, with adjustable cheekpiece and butt-plate). Daisy 887/888 rifles may have 2010 model replacement stocks. Any rifle not included in this list but complies with the requirements of the Sporter Air Rifle as stated in the National Standard Rules may be submitted to for a decision prior to the competition and may be added to the list of approved rifles. See CMP Rule Book (4.2 Sporter Air Rifle).

Clothing: Shoes are restricted to soft, low cut, athletic or street shoes that do not extend above the ankles. Shoes must be worn in all positions. No boots are permitted. A shooting glove may be worn, but no shooting jackets are permitted. Up to two sweatshirts or clothing suitable for the prevailing weather are allowed. Undergarments or clothing sold or known as "compression clothing" or "compression apparel" may not be worn. (See Clothing Rule 4.3)
