4-H COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION



Tennessee 4-H has 26 college scholarships from which 4-H members can select when they submit a college scholarship application. Applicants can select more than one scholarship.

GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR 4-H SCHOLARSHIPS

These rules apply to all scholarships unless indicated otherwise under the specific scholarship.

- I. Scholarships are open to all Tennessee 4-H members regardless of previous awards won.
- 2. Recipients must be an active Tennessee 4-H member.
- 3. Applicants will complete an online Tennessee 4-H scholarship application. The application can be accessed at: **tiny.utk.edu/4HScholarships24**.
- 4. The online process requires the 4-H'er to complete the Interactive Scholarship Application Worksheet first. This worksheet can be found here: <u>https://4h.tennessee.edu/wp-con</u> <u>tent/uploads/sites/47/2024/01/Interactive-Scholarship-Application-</u> <u>Worksheet.pdf</u>. Once completed, please reach out to your county agent for a review before completing the online form. Check with your county agent for the county application due date. The final, state, online application submission due date is May I. This is a firm deadline.
- 5. Scholarship recipients will be announced at State 4-H Roundup in July. Recipients are highly encouraged to attend this assembly since donors are invited and are usually present to meet recipients. If applicants are not attending 4-H Roundup, their 4-H agent will be notified in advance.
- 6. Read the requirements for each scholarship and **DO NOT** apply for a scholarship for which you do not meet the requirements.
- 7. The value of scholarships funded by an endowment will be determined annually according to the availability of funds. The amount shown on the 4-H Scholarship Listing Summary Document may be different from what the recipient actually receives.
- 8. Scholarship recipients may request payment for the award January 1, following the successful completion of one quarter or semester of college or schoolwork as a full time student. Successful completion is defined as a minimum, cumulative score of a 2.0 grade point average on a 4.0 grading system, unless the scholarship stipulates a higher GPA.
