## *What can I do...*

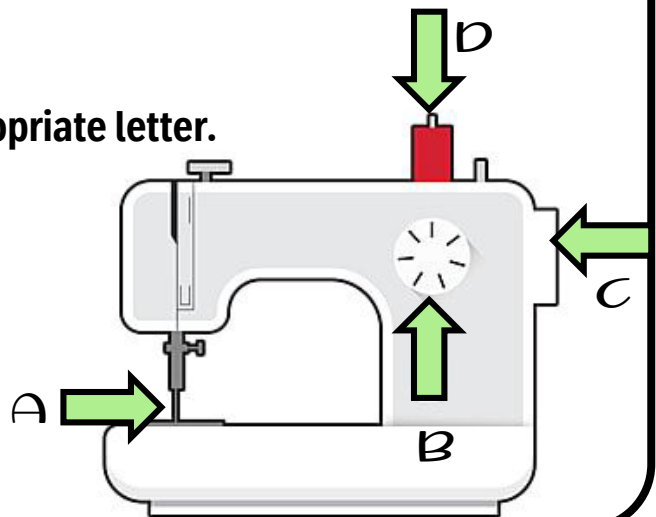
- Give a demonstration to your classmates on how to sew on a button
