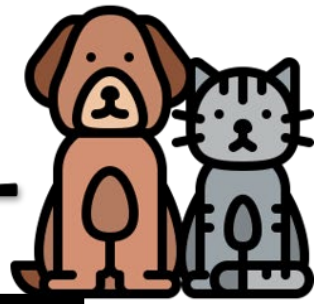


COMPANION ANIMAL
