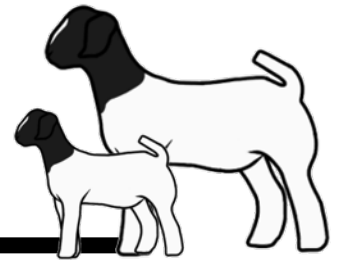


# GOAT

## *What can I do...*

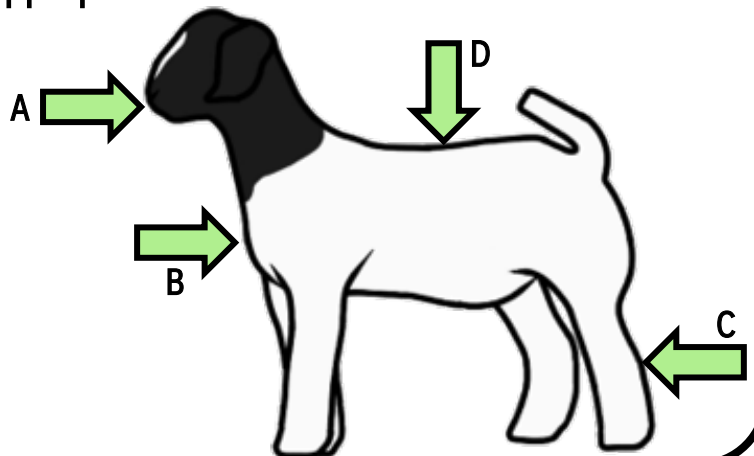
- Give a demonstration on how to vaccinate a goat
