## Supplies:

### List of Supplies:

- Stencils (I mailed to you last week)
- Your Art Work (collages or be sure to watch the videos sent out earlier in January for other ideas)
- Corn Starch\*\*\*
- White Acrylic Paint
- School Glue
- Glass Jar with Lid (reuse old baby food, pickle, jelly jars, old Mason® jars, etc...)
- Watercolors
- Brush
- Plastic Spoon or Knife
- Cleaning Supplies
  - Paper Towels
  - Water Cup
  - Soap

### Alternative Supplies:

- \*\*\* You can use baking soda or baby (Talcum) Powder instead. If you are using Baby (Talcum) Powder, please consider wearing a mask so that you don't inhale this product
- You can substitute a cup of coffee or a glass of tea for watercolors
