The Photo Search Contest lets youth showcase their photography skills. Each county sets its own deadline for entries. County Agents will submit their top 10 photos to the state office. The state deadline is April 30. All entries must be submitted online by the county agent by 11:59 p.m. ET that day. Check with your local county office for their specific deadline. Contest Rules

Eligibility

- Any 4-H'er in grades 4-12
- The 4-H'er must take the photo themselves

Taking Photos

- You may submit single photos or a series (up to 4 photos).
- A series shows a sequence or theme—like before-and-after.
- Photos must relate to 4-H (project work, events, camp, etc.).

Prepare Your Photos

- Format: JPEG
- Size: 8x10" or 2400x3000 pixels
- Name files like this: [Region] [County] [Initials] [#]
- Example: ER Jefferson KAS 1

Complete the Entry Form

- Fill out one entry form per photo or photo series.

Submit to Your County

- Submit your JPEG file(s) and completed form(s) by your county's due date.
- Your County Agent will handle uploading to the state.



Judging Criteria
